The RENEW JAX Core Premise:

Church renewal is as important as church planting. The birth rate of healthy churches must go up. The death rate of existing churches must decline. We believe it is possible to increase the likelihood a church is started in healthy ways. We likewise believe that there exists a core of practices that lead To healthier more effective disciple-making congregations.

RENEW JAX is a network of congregations that are continuously aligning and realigning their ministry activities with the purpose, priorities, and power of God through a shared journey of personal and organizational transformation.

The RENEW JAX Core Values

The core values that drive our behavior are the Deeply held beliefs that:

- Jesus is THE Church Revitalizer
- Jesus followers are invited to participate in His renewal process by "planting and watering" the gospel into the relationships, environments, and experiences of a congregation.
- Jesus followers are invited to trust and celebrate that "God gave the growth. So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth."

OVERVIEW

MINISTRY ROTATION MODULES:

During each ministry rotation your primary objectives are to serve and observe. Ministry in a replant is often approached differently than in larger or healthier churches. As you lead a church through a revitalization or replant you will need to be prepared to lead in any and every area of the church. You will also need to be prepared to lead with minimal resources and personnel. After each ministry rotation module the resident will turn in a 1-page (single-spaced) reflection paper on their observations. Some suggestions for what to write about:

- •What strengths did you observe in the leadership of this ministry?
- •What were the challenges that you observed in the ministry?
- •How did the leader(s) of this ministry approach the challenges in this ministry?
- •What did you learn that you may apply in your future ministry as a replanter?
- •How comfortable were you serving in this ministry area?
- •How could the leaders of this ministry improve this ministry with the existing resources?

EQUIPPING MODULES:

The equipping modules are designed for equipping the resident for pastoral ministry, specifically in a replanting context through intensive readings and coaching conversations. Each module will include at least one reading assignment and at least one coaching meeting. The resident will turn in a 2-page (single-spaced) paper per equipping module. This paper will need to summarize the highlights of the reading assignments and coaching conversations in one page. The second page will explain how the resident will apply the content to your future replanting ministry.

MINISTRY PROJECTS:

During your RENEWJAX residency you will work with the lead pastor to determine 1-3 ministry projects that will last the duration of your residency. These ministry projects will serve several purposes. First, your time as a resident should be a blessing to the church that is hosting and training you. Second, these projects are an opportunity for you to Implement the leadership principles you will be learning. Third, these projects give your resident leadership an opportunity to observe and evaluate you in action.

PREACHING OPPORTUNITIES:

Your RENEWJAX residency will come with several opportunities to preach. These may or may not be in the main corporate gathering of the church. These will be opportunities to be evaluated for encouragement and growth in this area of pastoral leadership. You will need to work with your resident leadership to arrange these opportunities.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPPORTUNITIES:

It is highly recommended that you participate in as many opportunities the JBA provides as you can. Especially Kairos Coaching. Your resident church may have other opportunities they desire you participate in as well.

RESIDENCY COMMITMENT:

The RENEWJAX Residency is a developmental residency designed to help church replanting and revitalization residents explore their vocational calling, be equipped for mission and ministry, being exposed to church replanting, and engage in missional living. The resident and the resident leadership are committed to live and serve in a manner worthy of the gospel (Phil. 1:27), by God's grace, seeking to love God with all they are, love others sacrificially, and exhibit integrity and grace. The resident commits to submit to the leadership of the resident leader and the resident leader commits to treat the resident in a manner that is respectful and edifying.
